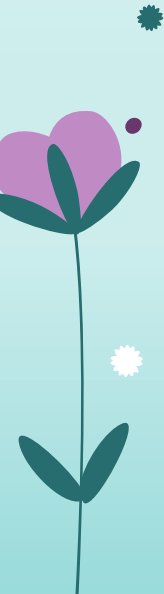
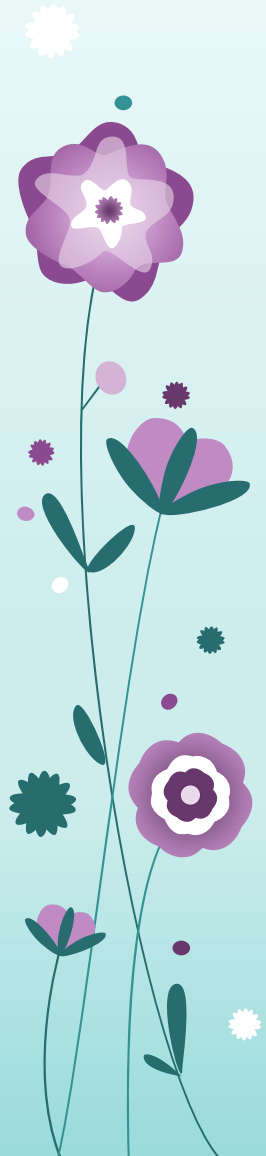
The aims of our project are to:

- Encourage the children themselves to have a say in the kind of garden project they want, to help submit outline plans or designs, and to help create and maintain the garden;



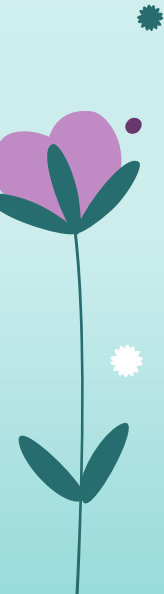
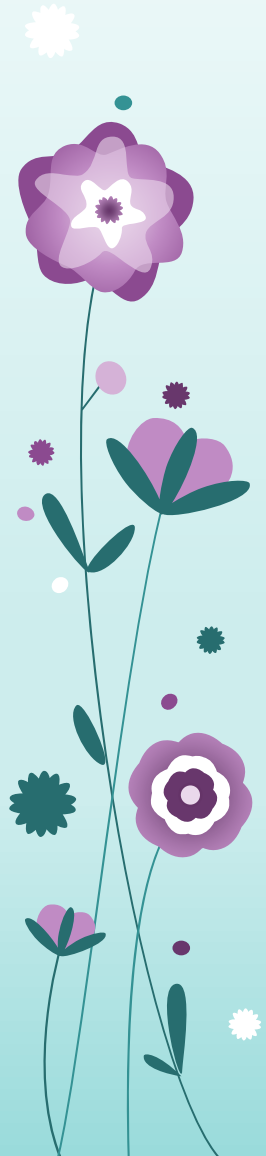
The aims of our project are to:


- Increase levels of wellbeing amongst the children and parents in our community;

In order to achieve these aims, we will require the following items:


- Raised beds for elder members of the community to access them

- Pots



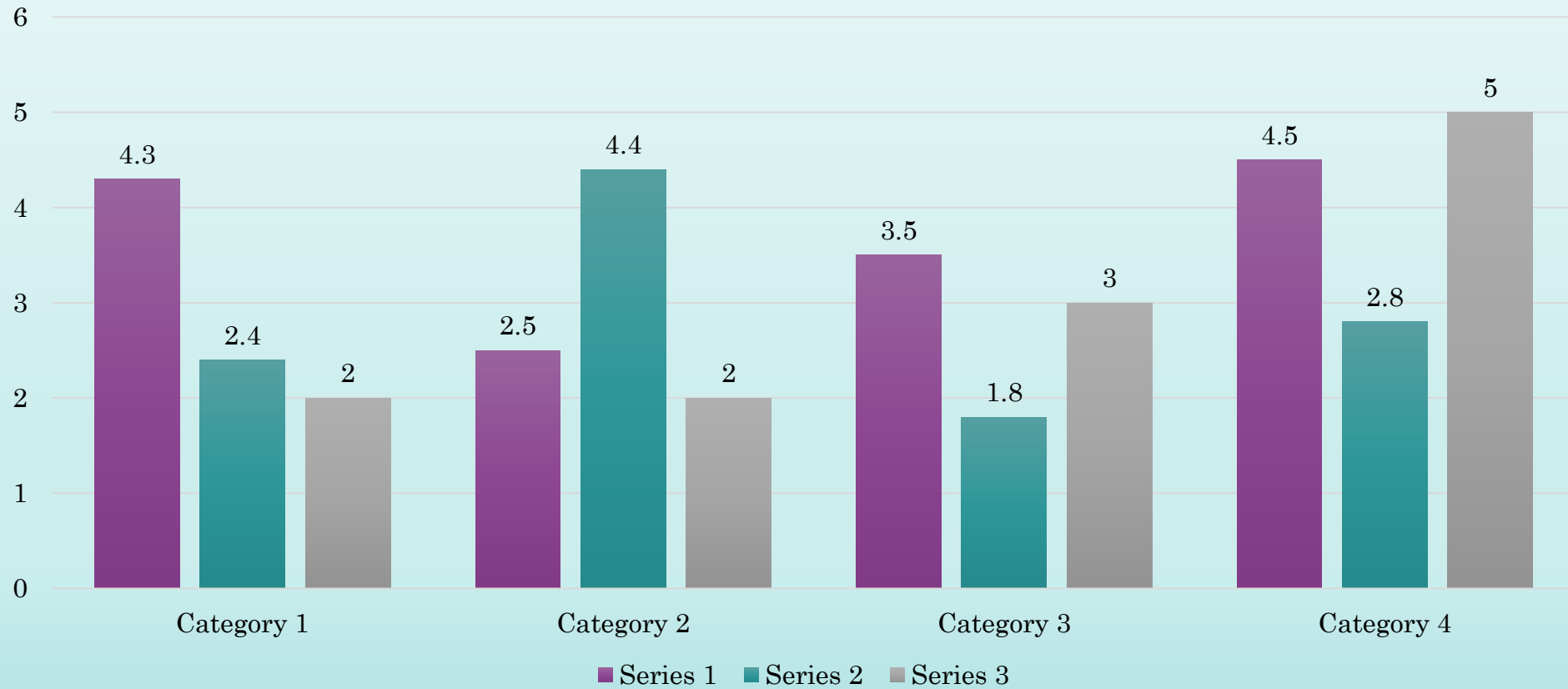
