Name of organisation	Summary of project	Amount applied for
1 st Devoran Rainbows	Learning skills – Look and Learn. Taking part in musical activities, up to 12 Rainbows (girls from 5 to 7 years) to buy children’s percussion pack, hand bells, “Lets Hear it for Music” CD and book. The Rainbows would be able to explore different basic instruments with their friends.	£90
1 st Devoran Brownies	Fit and Active You (Confidence and Team Building). Up to 24 Brownies (girls from 7 to 10 years) taking part in active sport and team games, to buy agility slats, balance rockers, play stilts, balance domes, bean bags, balls, floor cones, skipping ropes, colour dice and flexi balls.	£150
Devoran Village Hall	Internet access and support for residents at Devoran Village Hall. A survey has identified the need for internet classes and we have found a tutor to deliver initial classes for free, £1000 is needed to pay for the internet connection and line rental for one year and this money would go towards the cost. Hoping to set up weekly social sessions for residents based around this.	£250
Devoran – Theatre for Children	Theatre for Children in Devoran – to subsidise the cost of tickets for performances of children’s theatre in the Village Hall or Parish Centre, and to provide high quality performances and create interactive community events.	£250
St Feock Pals	St Feock Lunch Club , 2 course hot meals will be served fortnightly in the Church hall. Aim to provide nutritious home cooked meals and company to a predominantly elderly population. Funding would be spent on saucepans, serving dishes, tumblers, jugs, condiment sets, table mats, hot plate server.	£250

Name of organisation	Summary of project	Amount applied for
Devoran Pre-School	Outdoor wooden playhouse , the funding would go towards the cost of a wooden play house which can cost between £300 to £600. This would enhance the outside learning environment for the children and encourage imaginative play.	£250
Truro River Rowing Club (based at Loe Beach)	Purchase new pilot gig , to enable more people to take part in competitive sport of rowing, encouraging healthy lifestyles and activity. A new gig costs £21,400 and the funding would go towards this. We have secured £10,500 already from other funding sources.	£250
17 th Truro Scout Group (Devoran)	New tent for Scout Group camps , the scout group in Devoran has almost a 100 members aged between 6 to 16 years (both boys and girls), the funding would pay for a Vango 5 man tent which can be used by the whole group. Camping is one of the most popular activities and several tents need replacing due to their heavy use, a new tent would kick start the stock of tents.	£250
