



Devoran church is built from a foundation stone dating back to an amazing 1854!



Can you find the plaque commemorating the life of the famous Lobb brothers. They were famous, international plant hunters from the 1800s.



Your starting point is Devoran Village Hall. Turn right onto Market St.

Past the church of St. John and St. Petroc. Continue up the farm lane until you cross over a stile on your left.

Along the edge of a field and first right across the farmers field until you reach an old, stone stile. Continue along the lane, turn right through a large metal gate. Go through two more gates and along some wooded lanes until you go down a steep track..

At the bottom, turn right on to a small road, then first left. You should find Devoran Quay, straight ahead. Finally walk along Quay Road and you will arrive back at Devoran Village Hall.
